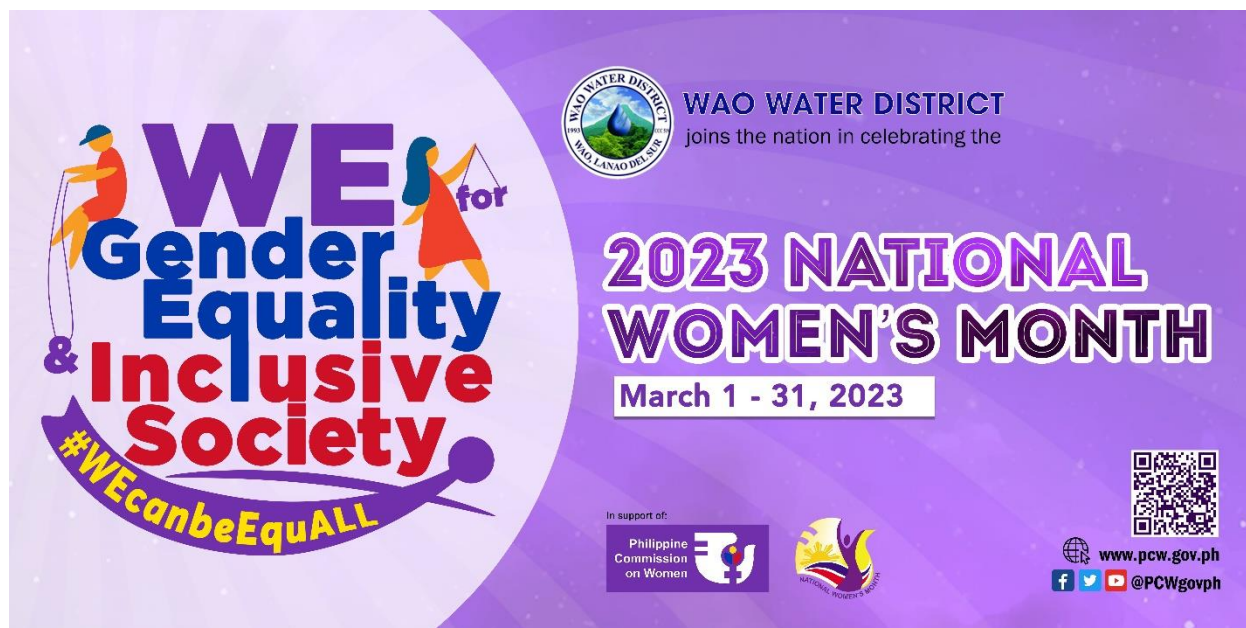


**“2023 National Women’s Month Celebration”
